SAE member captures road-racing titles

SAE International member Ed Milich completed his 2006 road-racing season with an undefeated record, a championship title, and the No. 1 plate in the American Historic Racing Motorcycle Association (AHRMA) Vintage Superbike Middleweight class following the Barber Motorsports AHRMA event, October 20-22.

In 2006, he captured victories at Daytona International Speedway, Willow Springs (CA), Miller Motorsports (UT), Sandia Motorsports (NM), and Barber Motorsports (AL). The championship-winning 65-hp (48-kW) Ducati displaces 650cc and was built and tuned by Milich. The bike was clocked at 129 mph (208 km/h) on the front straight at Daytona.

Milich also took the championship in the Vintage Lightweight (0-650cc) Class in Southern California's premier road-racing organization, Willow Springs Motorcycle Club.

Milich received degrees in mechanical engineering from Ohio State. He is currently a California Registered Professional Engineer and Senior R&D Engineer with a specialty in vehicle dynamics, mechanical vibrations, and testing at Measurement Analysis, an engineering consulting firm in Torrance, CA.
